

Preimplantation Genetic Diagnosis in the United Kingdom

Annual details of cycles and cancellations, pregnancies and live births per treatment cycle, and pregnancies and live births per embryo transferred can be found using the links in the table below. The searches can be refined by age and year by changing the criteria on the HFEA online form.

The searches for Guy's Hospital (rest of the UK) show that for the year ending 4th quarter 2009, 148 (99) fresh cycles of PGD were started, 86% (79%) had at least one embryo transferred and 36% (25%) resulted in a live birth, 13% (24%) of which were multiple births. There were also 31 (9) cycles using frozen embryos and 13% (33%) resulted in a live birth.
